Number of Staff & Equipment	Central Shropshire is patrolled by: Five targeted Patrol teams with a total of 49 officers, including a dedicated sergeant per team, who operate from Shrewsbury police station at Monkmoor. Six Safer Neighbourhood Teams comprising eight officers, plus one sergeant and 12 Police Community Support Officers, who operate from Shrewsbury and Pontesbury police stations. Shrewsbury town centre has a dedicated team of three police officers and three PCSOs who operate from Shrewsbury police station at Monkmoor.
Specification	Working to protect the public from harm, reducing the fear of crime and bringing offenders to account. We aim to achieve this by: Delivering an effective emergency response function. Using the national intelligence model and national decision making model to target organised crime groups, drug dealers and others who cause harm. Active involvement in the Shrewsbury Shop Watch Scheme to prevent repeat offenders from frequenting retail outlets within Shrewsbury. Disrupt harm caused by alcohol misuse through partnership working with local authorities and licensees. Active involvement with Shrewsbury Pub Watch Scheme to prevent repeat offenders frequenting licensed premises in Shrewsbury. Deliver supportive and effective response to victims of crime and anti-social behaviour taking account of needs and vulnerabilities. Safer Neighbourhood Teams work with partner agencies to resolve community issues such as ASB, vandalism etc. West Mercia Police has a Local Policing Community Charter which provides the strategic framework to guide and drive operational activity.
